What is TruServe?

- Grant reporting
- Annual Reports
- Monitoring program progress
- Demonstrating reach/impact
- Internal communication and planning

TruServe is now used by over 40 rural health agencies across the country, with the majority being SORHs.

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It's all You

- Each organization has their own TruServe site with a unique url. Staff log into the site, create activity records for the work they do and capture different types of information about their activities.
- Each organization is also able to customize the way in with they capture the data.

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Entering Data




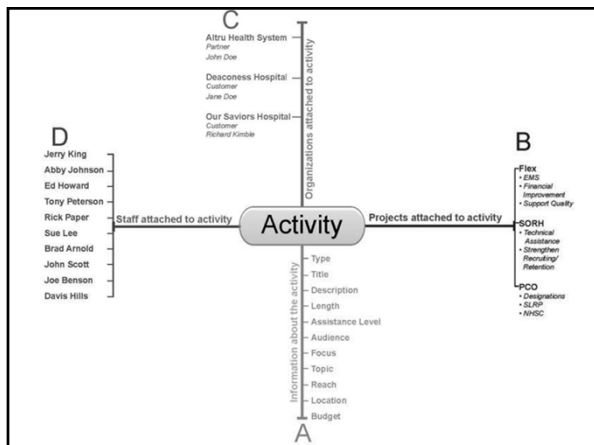
- Type of activity
- Date
- Length of time
- Level of Assistance provided
- Focus (or subject)
- Location
- Mode of delivery

In addition,


- Staff members can be attached to activities
- Programs and specific program goals can be tagged on each activity record
- Organizations/people that you work with can be attached to the activity record
- Demographics of groups can be captured for the activity
- Files can be attached to specific activity records

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Entering Data



Any of the data entered can later be reported on. For example, reports can be created for all work done related to a specific program, program goal, location, by staff member, or according to type (such as technical assistance).

- track impacts related to activities and stand-alone impacts
- report on impacts
- track committees
