

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FY 14 Awards

- > FY14 is 24th year of the SORH program!
 - FY14 appropriation ~ \$ 9.5M, ~\$500K *less* than FY 13.
 No sequestration but FY 14 awards ~ same FY 13.
- > Awarded ~\$8.6M in FY 14, 45 States received \$172,950 (~5% less than FY 12 awards \$180K).
- Others \$168K (1), \$163K (2), \$158K (1) & \$153K (1).
- > 11 states had off-set of FY 12 un-obligated funds totaling \$159K (\$208K prior year).

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FY 15 NCC


- > FY 15 NCC Progress Report instructions scheduled to be released December 16th.
- > Webinar December 18th.
- > Due in EHB by February 12, 2015.
- > Essentially the same as FY 13 NCC.
- New requirement for two Work Plans Current and Future.
- Progress Report Narrative must *align* with Work Plan activities.

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FY 13 SORH PIMS

- > Total TA decreased from <u>85,600</u> to <u>82,549</u> (~1%).
- Total Unduplicated Clients decreased from <u>28,496</u> to <u>26,574</u> (~1%).
- > Ratio of TA to Client remained the same 3:1.
- Distinguishing affiliated versus non-affiliated clients still issue for some.
- Will provide display and analysis of five year trend (FY 09 -13) before end of year.

 Request feedback on FFR submission process.
- > FY 13 carryover requests due by Nov. 30th.
 - Cannot be for new activities.

- > FY16 will be Competitive Continuation.
 - Considering 5 year project period.NOSORH input welcomed!
