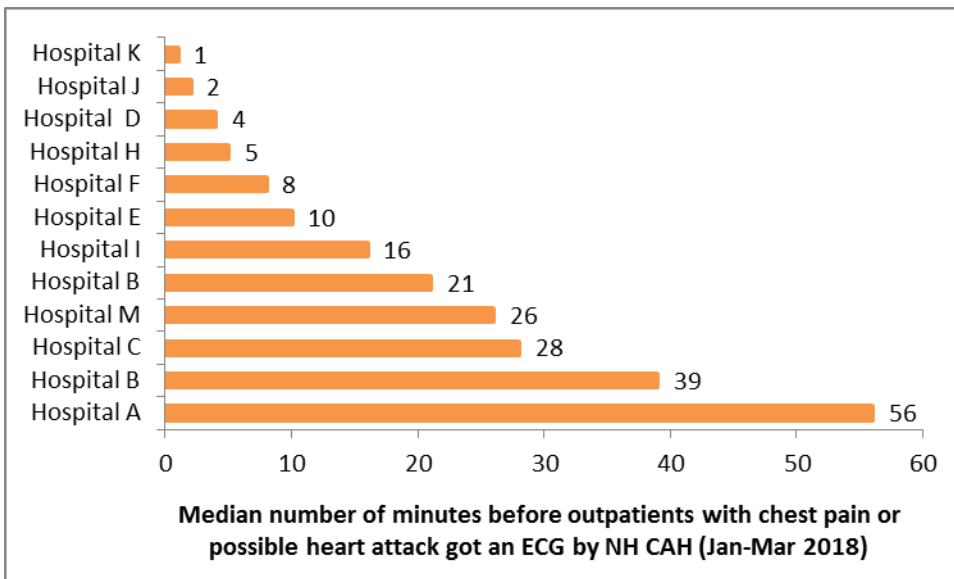




Improving Cardiac Care NH Critical Access Hospitals

New Hampshire Critical Access Hospitals have varying rates of providing timely access to an ECG for patients arriving in their emergency departments with heart attack symptoms or chest pain.



50% of CAHs did not provide timely heart attack care in Q1 2018

When few patients arrive in the ED with symptoms of heart attack, staff may have little practice, and clear processes may not be in place to assure timely care. How can we work together to identify and share best practices and improve care for patients presenting with heart attack or chest pain?
