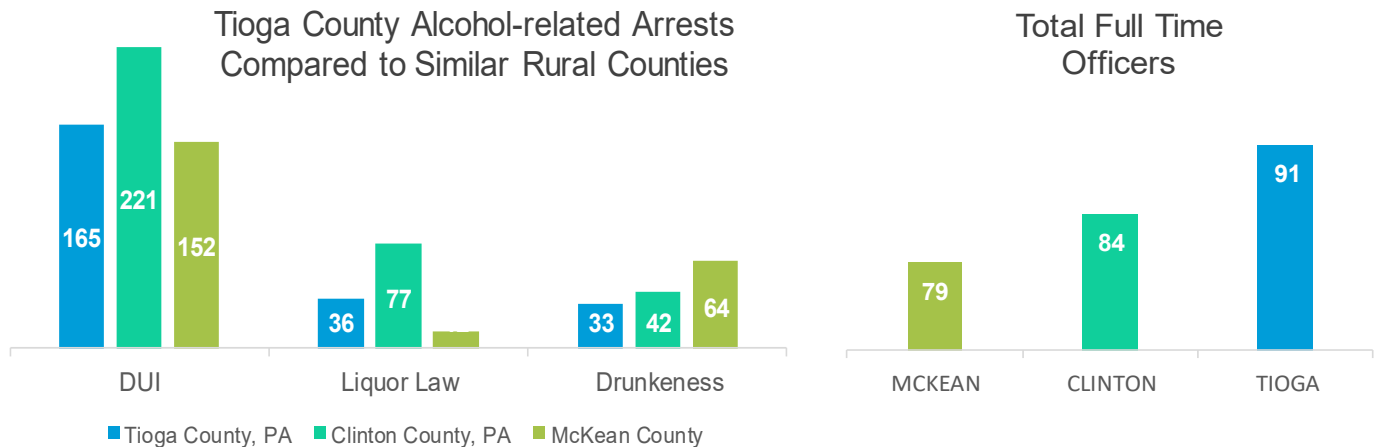


# Tioga County has a lower number of alcohol related arrests and a greater law enforcement presence,

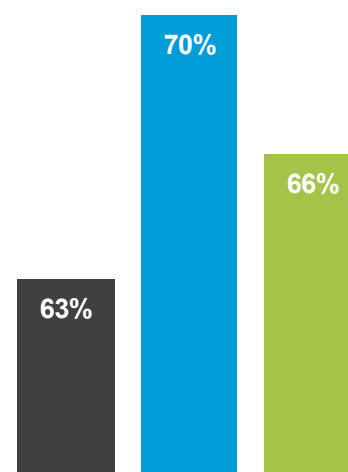
When compared to similar counties Tioga County, PA has less than average DUI, Liquor Law, and Drunkenness violations.\*

\*Liquor law violations include, with the exceptions of drunkenness and driving under the influence, all offenses related to alcohol. Some violations included are unlawful manufacturing, sale and transportation of alcoholic beverages; bootlegging; operation of a still; and consumption of alcoholic beverages by a minor.
