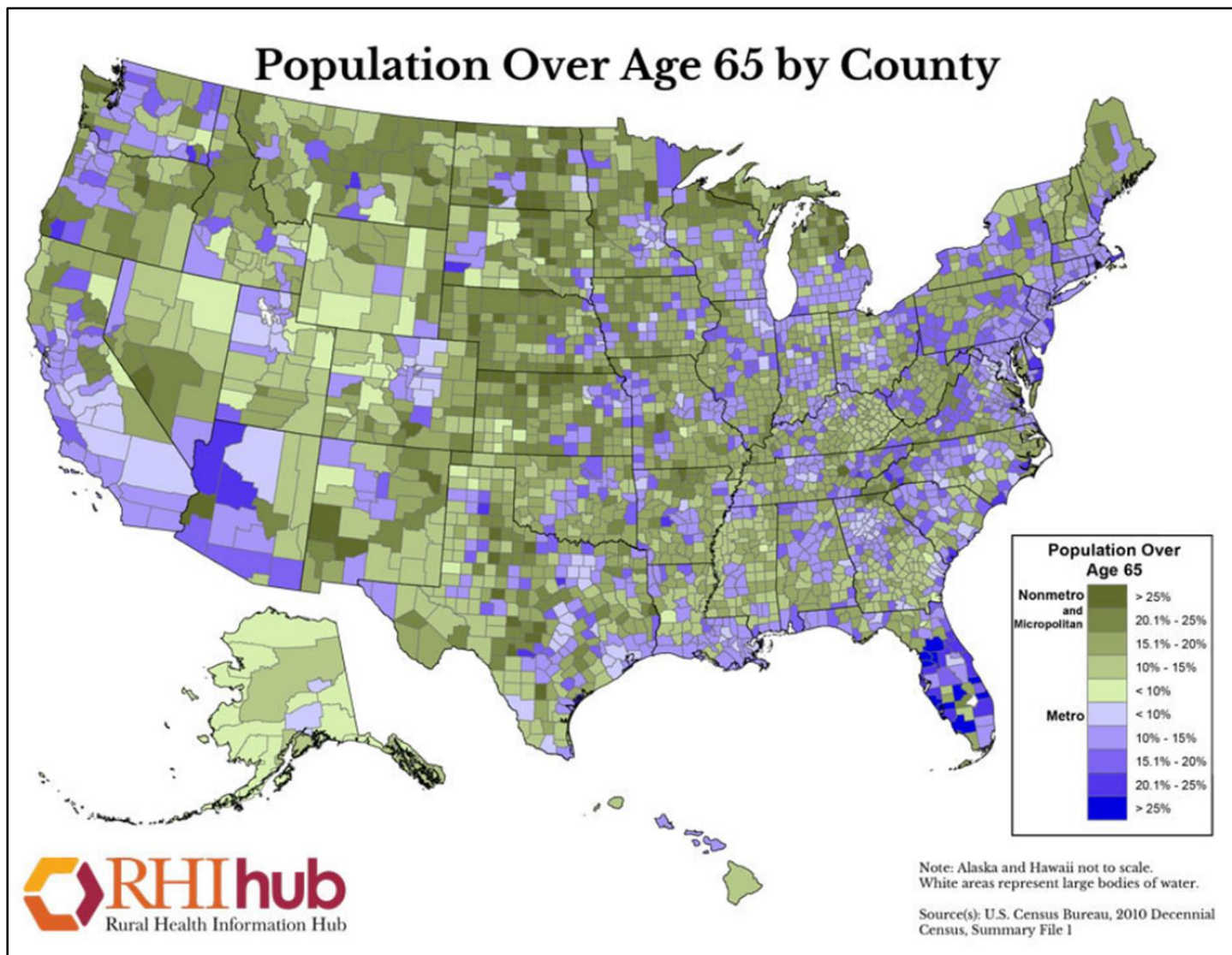

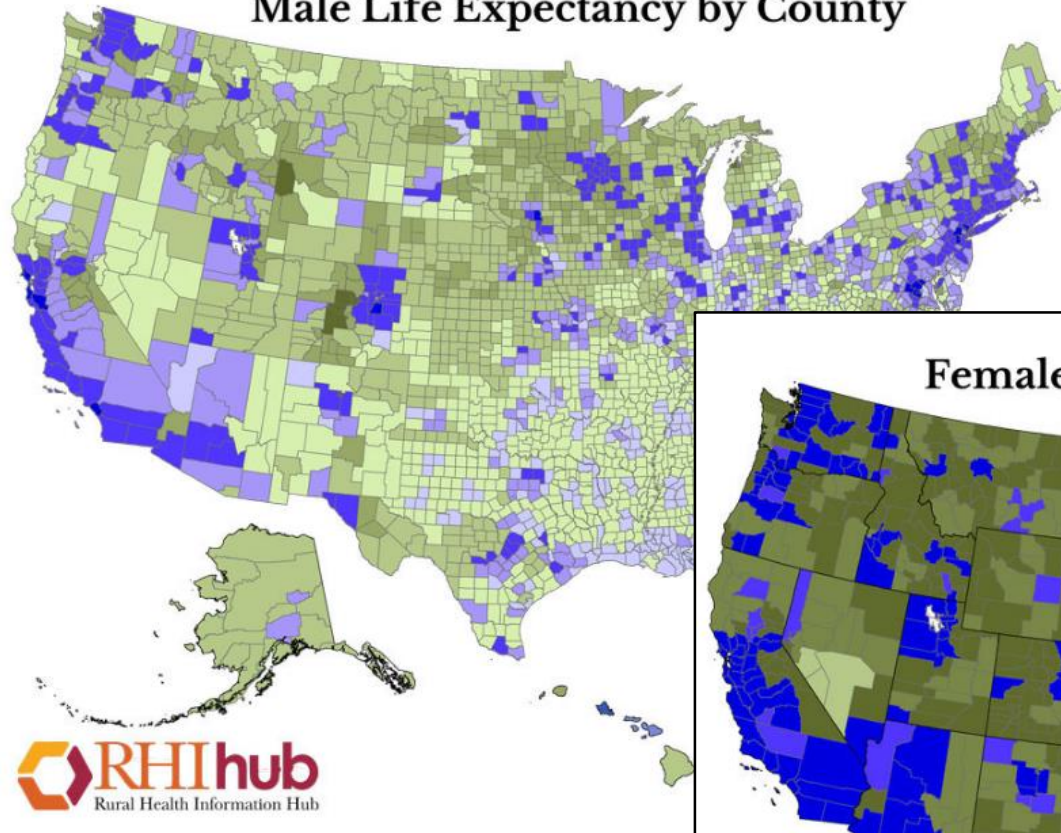

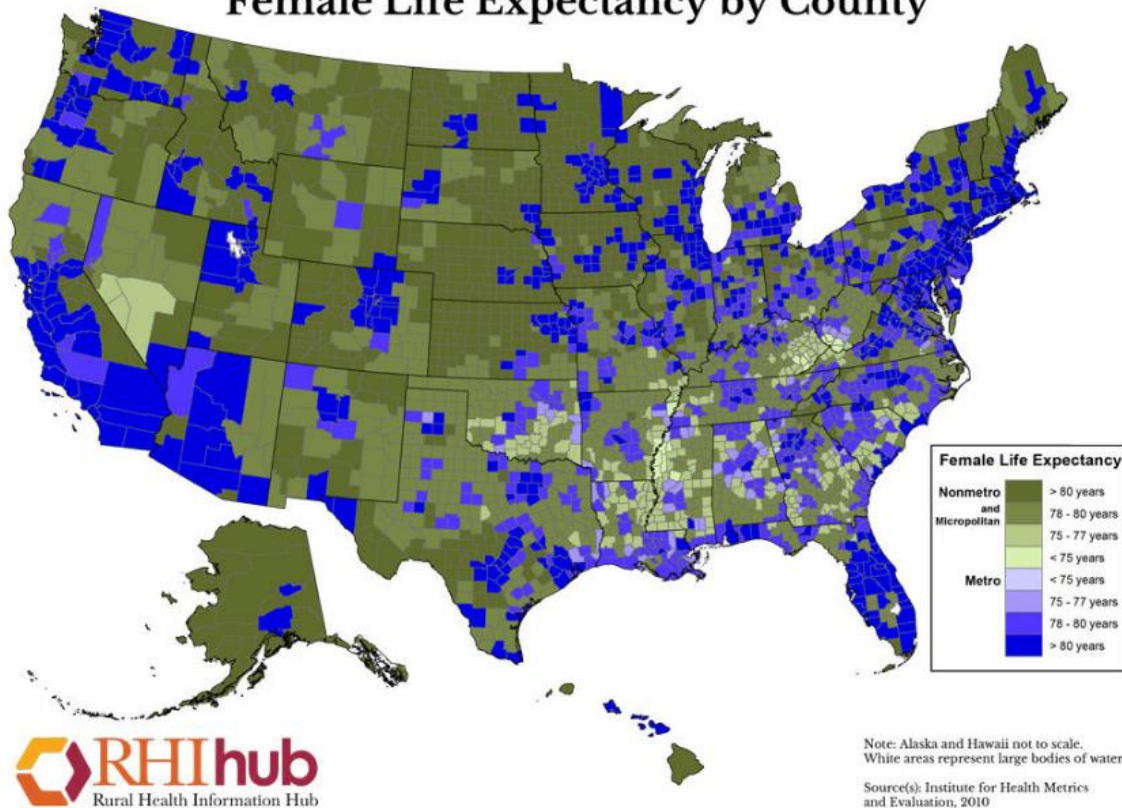
Male Life Expectancy by County

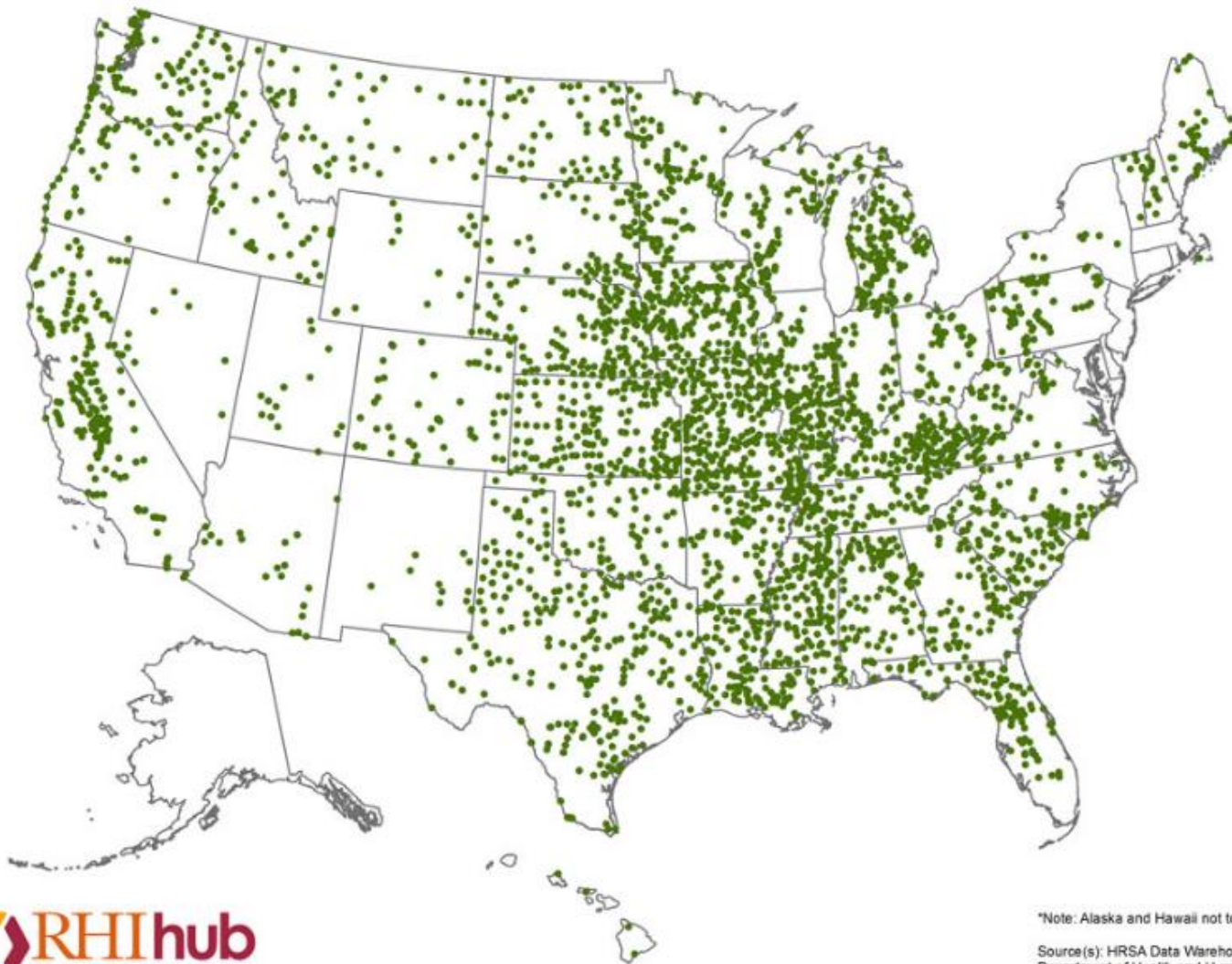

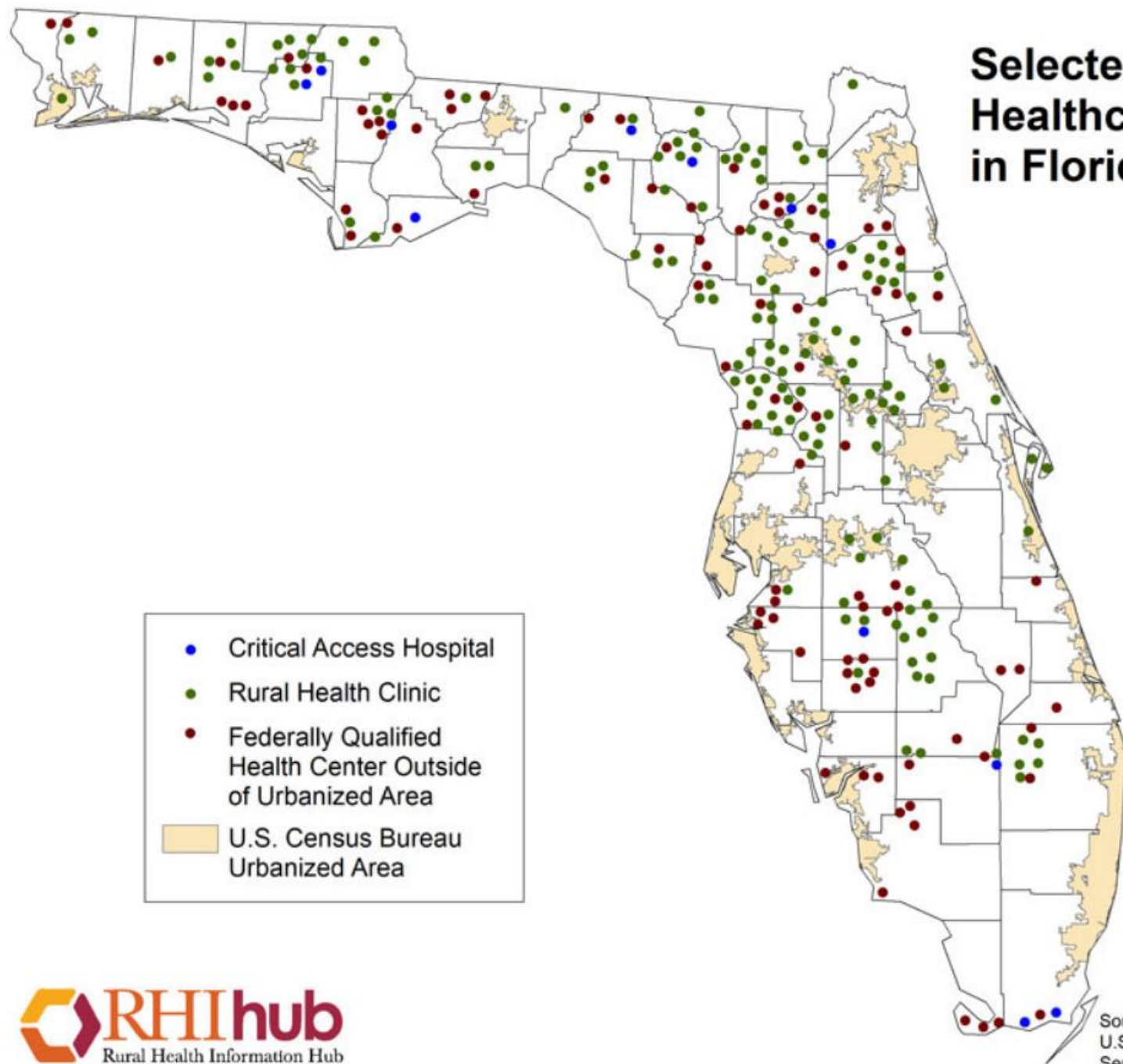

Alcohol Use in Past Month for Metro and Nonmetro Counties, Ages 21 and Over, 2015

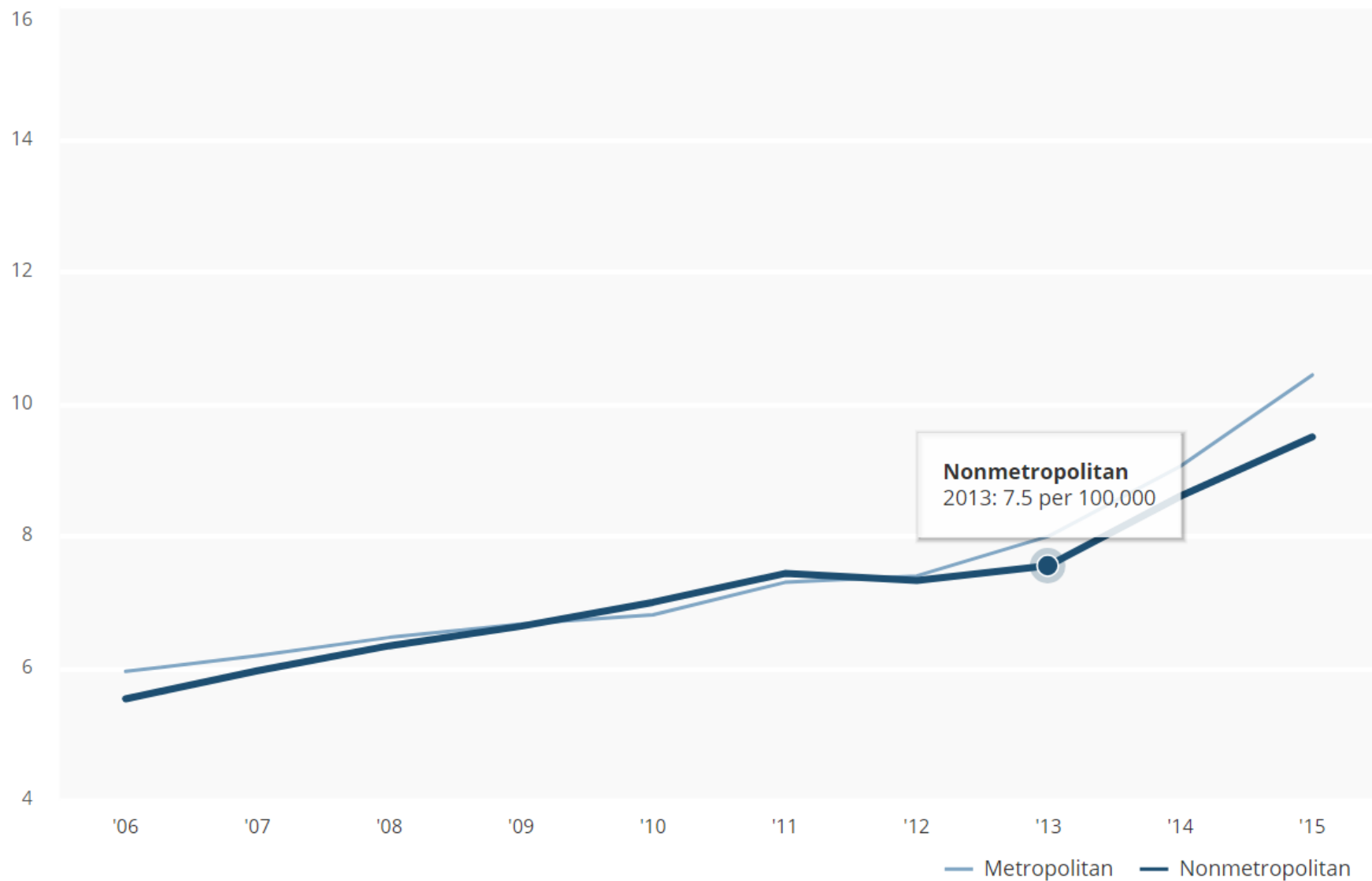

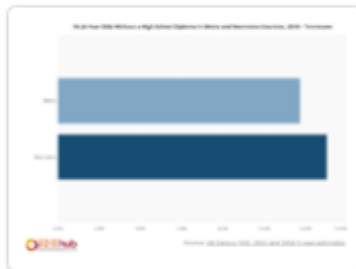
Opioid Overdoses (Including Heroin) per 100,000 for Metro and Nonmetro Counties, 2006-2015

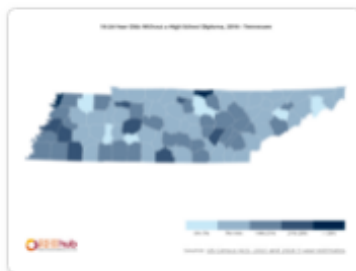

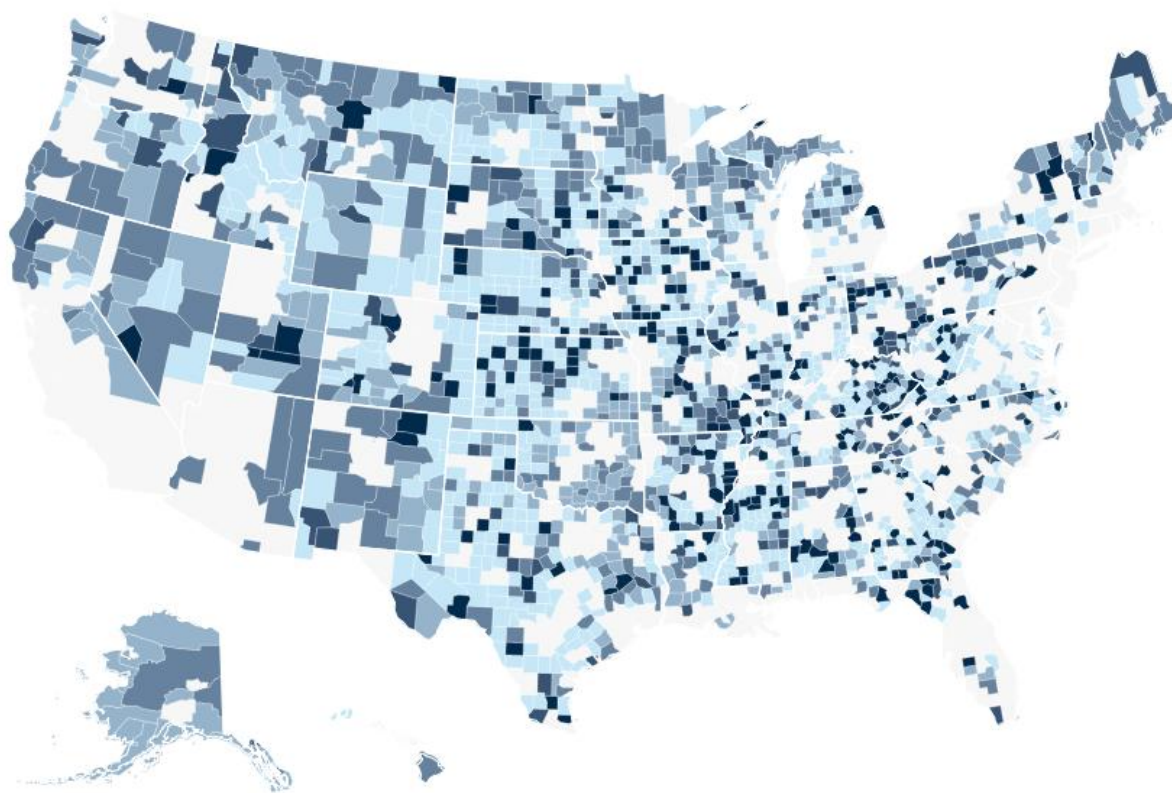

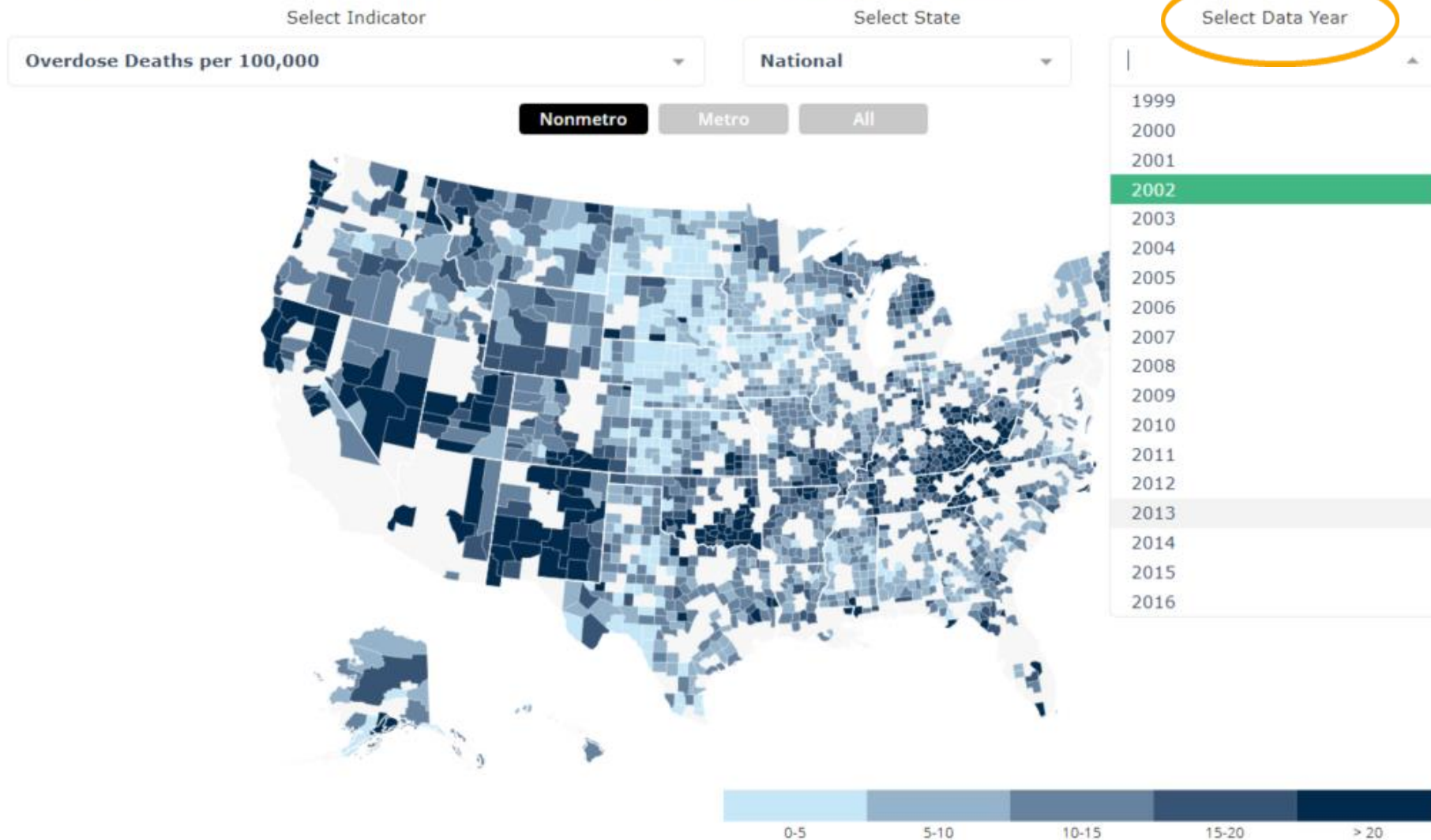
