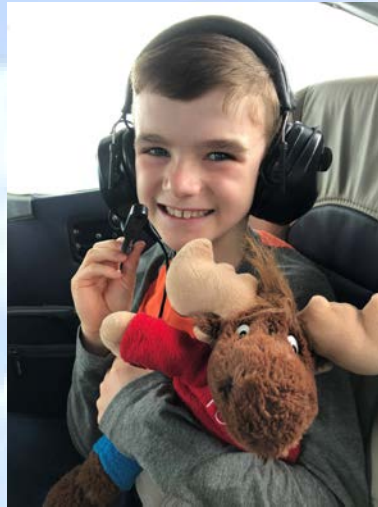
Our History

- We have grown from 17 flights in our first year to over 900 flights per year

Angel Flight East (AFE) provides free air transportation to qualified children and adults in need of medical treatment far from home and other humanitarian needs. Volunteer pilots use their own aircraft and pay for all costs of the flight.

AFE covers a 14 state territory (Virginia to Ohio to Maine) and for destinations beyond, we link up with other volunteer pilot organizations. Passengers are required to be ambulatory and cleared by a doctor to fly in a small non-pressurized aircraft.








Patient Paperwork

- Patients are required to be medically stabilized and ambulatory to board a small aircraft
- Before scheduling a flight, AFE requires the following paperwork to be filled out-
 - Worksheet for requesting AFE flight
 - Medical Approval Form
 - Need Verification Form
 - Air Transport Waiver of Liability
 - Maximum Luggage Disclaimer
 - Photo/Media Release

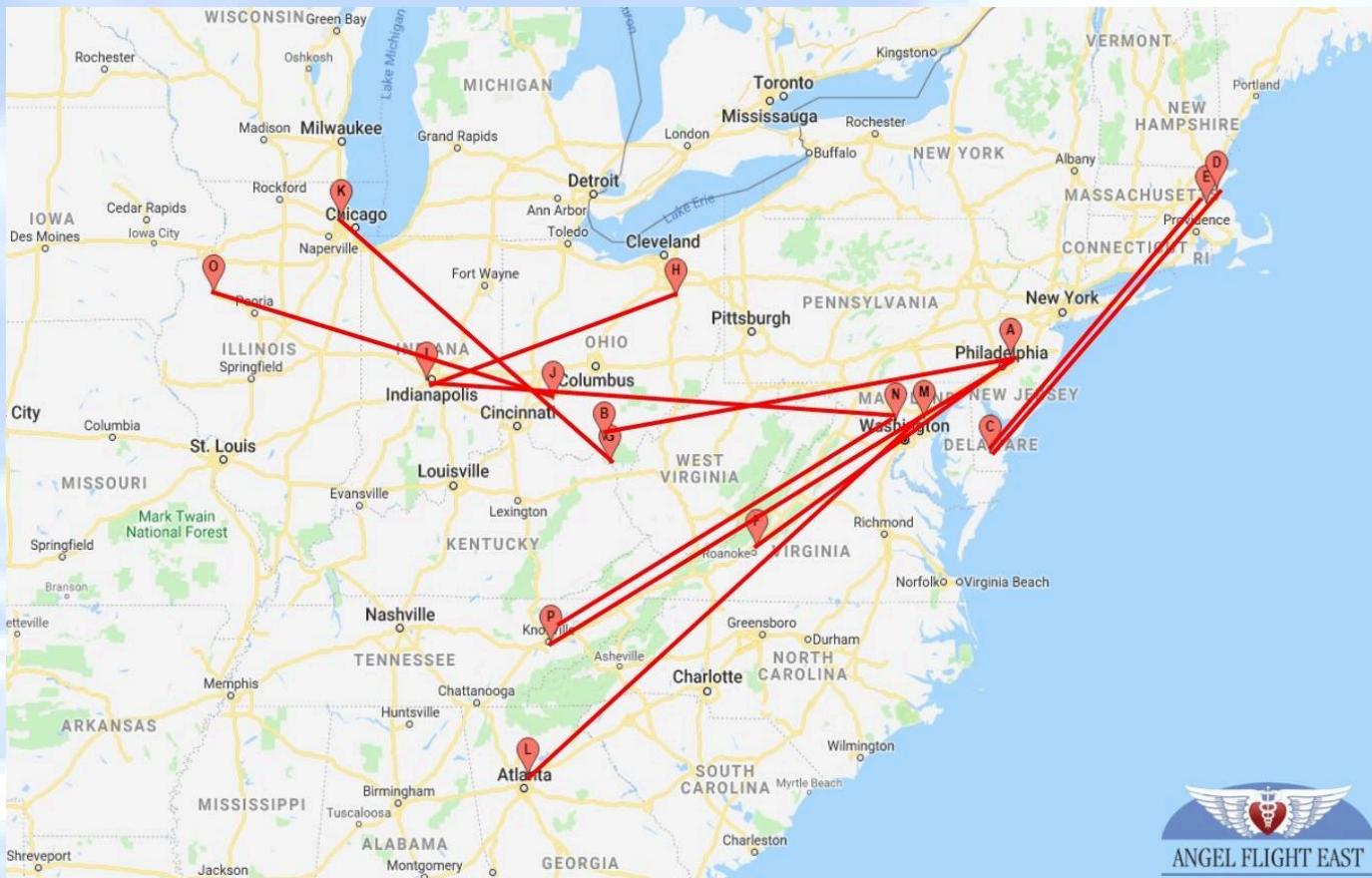
