Workforce – to build a vital workforce and expand the capacity of primary care providers

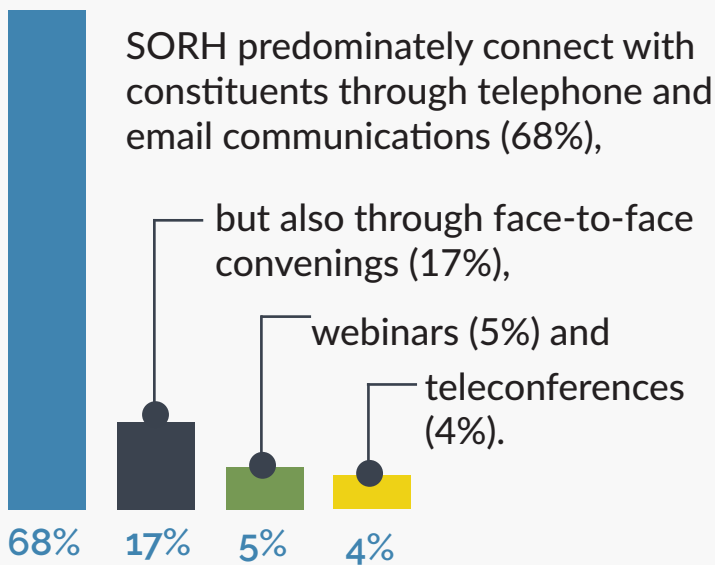
Transformation – to ensure SORH have the data and resources on model programs to grow vital systems of high value care

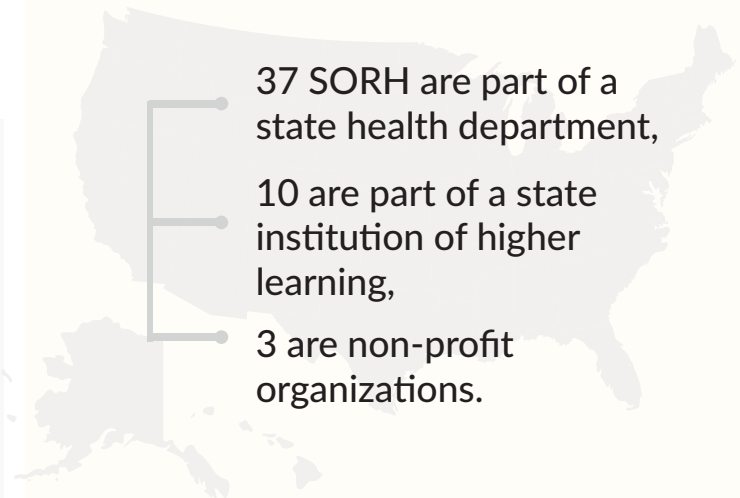
