What is National Rural Health Day?

In 2020, the National Organization of State Offices of Rural Health, the 50 State Offices of Rural Health, and rural health stakeholders from across the country celebrated the 10th Annual National Rural Health Day (NRHD).

NRHD is recognized on the third Thursday of November. Its purpose is to celebrate and promote the "Power of Rural," bringing much-needed attention to the ongoing efforts to communicate, educate, collaborate, and innovate to improve the health of an estimated 57 million people who call rural and frontier areas home.

Over the past decade, NRHD has transformed a day-long event into a sustainable movement, as evidenced by the engagement from a wide-ranging national audience.



Three NRHD press releases were distributed in 2020, resulting in **554 publications** in media outlets across the country, as well as over **3,000 Google pick-ups** and **8,700 viewer impressions**.
